



OUTLETS NOT WORKING:

- First, check the fuse panel for a tripped fuse.

- If the outlet is near the kitchen, garage, bathroom or any outlet near a water supply, it could be a GFCI outlet or controlled by a GFCI outlet. Please reset the GFCI outlet by pushing the red button in the center. If the outlet itself is not a GFCI but is close to a GFCI outlet, it could be controlled by the GFCI, and resetting the outlet may resolve this issue.

- Sometimes an outlet is controlled by a switch in a room, please make sure all switches are on and test the outlet again. You may need to use a process of elimination to find the switch that controls the outlet.
